

Ellesmere College Riyadh Uniform Policy

Introduction:

At Ellesmere College Riyadh, we uphold a uniform dress code to foster a sense of community, ensure equality among students, and prepare them for a professional environment. Our policy reflects the school's commitment to discipline, unity, and a respectful learning atmosphere.

Uniform Standards:

Daily Wear:

All students must wear the official school uniform daily unless specified otherwise for special occasions or non-uniform days.

PE Kit:

 The PE kit is required for Physical Health Education (PHE) classes. Students should use change rooms before and after these classes for convenience and comfort.

Presentation:

- Uniforms should be clean, well-maintained, and worn properly to reflect pride in the school and personal grooming standards.
- Any accessories worn with the uniform should be modest, functional, and not detract from the uniformity of the dress code.

Seasonal Variations:

- The school may introduce seasonal variations to the uniform, such as lighter materials for hotter months or additional layers for the colder season.
- Variations for special events or dress-down days will be communicated in advance.

Non-Compliance:

- Strict adherence to the uniform policy is expected of all students. Non-compliance will be addressed according to the school's disciplinary procedures.
